Dear Colleague,

On June 1, 2014, the State of Nevada Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) launched the **Health Care Guidance Program**—a new Care Management Organization (CMO) designed to assist Nevada's sickest and costliest Fee-for-Service Nevada Medicaid patients.

Up to 41,500 Medicaid patients will be eligible to participate in the **Health Care Guidance Program**. The program is designed to help improve health outcomes for individuals who live with chronic health conditions by offering additional support to these patients and their providers.

The Health Care Guidance Program is administered by McKesson Care Management and DHCFP and has the authority to access the personal health information of Health Care Guidance Program participants through the contractual agreements in place between DHCFP and McKesson.

Our staff will be reaching out to your office to request current Medicaid patient information to update participating patient records. They may also fax you a Health Care Guidance Program recommendation form to alert you to any potential patient concerns that may need your attention. Please note, these assessments and care coordination activities are offered in the spirit of collaborative care and your patient-prescribed treatment plan will always take precedence.
