COVID-19 Pandemic Response

- UNR Med's Nevada State Public Health Lab (NSPHL) and Department of Microbiology and Immunology partnered with Nevada Genomics Center to complete DNA sequencing on COVID-19 cases
- NSPHL implemented plan for antibody testing, including conducting three antibody studies.
- NSPHL-led team identified first documented case of reinfection in the U.S.
- UNR Med and Renown Health launched convalescent plasma study
- Project ECHO supported over 360 rural and urban health care professionals through its weekly COVID-19 sessions
- Clinical Research Center generated qualitative data in the COVID-19 immune response from recovered patients



- Sanford Center for Aging partnered on Nevada CAN, a statewide coordination of aging services

- More than 100 medical and PA students contributed over 5,000 volunteer hours in support of Nevada's health care workers – from staffing testing and phone triage sites to providing child and elder care

As of Sept. 16, 2020 the NSPHL has processed more than 147,000 diagnostic COVID-19 tests.



A holistic approach: Our medical student interview process evaluates the entire applicant, including academic readiness, professionalism and commitment to patient care. More than half of the Class of 2024 represent UNR Med mission-based diversity groups, reflecting Nevada's diverse population.
